NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

INTERRUPTION OF WATER SUPPLY

The Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company would like to inform its esteemed customers that there will be a partial shutdown of the Ngethu Water Treatment Plant on Thursday 14th July 2022 from 6.00am to Mid Night the same day.

This shutdown will facilitate interconnection and testing of the new Kiambu Embakasi pipeline by the contractor.

It will also involve carrying out scheduled maintenance at Ngethu Water Treatment Plant and the Ngethu Gigiri transmission mains to improve on our services.

During the shutdown the following areas will not receive water supply:

- The whole of City Centre, University of Nairobi main campus, Coca Cola Factory, Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, EPZ-Athi river, Mlolongo area, Gatundu and kiambu towns
- Areas along Mombasa road: South B, South C and the neighbourhoods including Embakasi Area
- The whole of Industrial area
- Areas along Juia road: Mlango Kubwa, the whole of Mathare, Eastleigh Airforce Base, Huruma. Kariobangi, Pangani and Eastleigh
- Areas along Jogoo road: Maringo, Buruburu and the surrounding estates, Bahati
- Areas along Outer-ring road: Baba dogo, Dandora, Dandora KCC factory, Umoja Estate 1 & 2, Donholm, Fedha, Tassia, Avenue Park, Nyayo Embakasi
- Areas along Kangundo Road: Ruai, Kavole, Komorock estate, Mwiki and Niiru
- Areas along Thika road: Kenya Breweries, Kenyatta University, Kahawa Barracks, Kasarani, Mwiki, Kahawa Sukari, Garden Estate and Thome Estate
- Areas along Limuru road: Parklands, Ngara area, Aga Khan hospital, University of Nairobi - School of Law and City Park Area, Gigiri, United Nation- Gigiri, Muthaiga
 - Areas along Naivasha road and Kikuyu Road, Kawangware, Riruta/Satellite, Uthiru, Ndwaru Road
- Area along James Gichuru road, Langata road and Waiyaki way, Riverside, Westlands, Lavington, Kilimani, Kileleshwa,
- Areas along Lang'ata Road: Madaraka, Karen, Lang'ata and Kibra

Whilst every effort will be made to restore the supply of water as soon as possible, we request all customers in the affected areas to use water sparingly during the period of interruption. Any inconvenience is highly regretted.
